Isaiah ministered from 740BC for approximately 40 Years

Southern Kingdom of Judah

4 Kings:

Uzziah (also called Azariah)-Ok

Jotham – Ok

Ahaz – Bad

Hezekiah – Pretty Good but Flawed

Important Dates:

722BC – Northern Kingdom Falls to Assyria

701BC – Sennacherib sieges Jerusalem

605BC – Babylonian captivity begins

538BC- Persia Conquers Babylon and allow Israelites to return
